### Who Can Pull Electrical Permits?

1. A person who holds a license as a Master Electrician shall be authorized to obtain site improvement permits to perform electrical work on any Class 1, Class 2, or related structures.
2. A person who holds a license as a Master Residential Electrician shall be authorized to obtain site improvement permits to perform electrical work on any Class 2 or related structures, but not on Class 1 or related structures.

### Electrician License Requirements

1. Master Electrician – must have scored at least 75% on the Master Electrician exam and have no less than four years of equivalent full-time experience performing electrical work on any combination of Class 1 or Class 2 structures.
2. Journeyman Electrician – must have scored at least 70% on the Journeyman Electrician exam and have no less than two years of equivalent full-time experience performing electrical work on any combination of Class 1 or Class 2 structures.
3. Master Residential Electrician – must have scored at least 70% on the Master Residential Electrician exam and have no less than two years of equivalent full-time experience performing electrical work on Class 2 structures.
